



Alma Gayle Bodell

October 3, 1952 - February 17, 2020

Alma Gayle (Henson) Bodell, 67, of Martinsville, unexpectedly passed from this life into the arms of Jesus on Monday, February 17, in her home. She was born on October 3, 1952, in Indianapolis, to the late Aaron and Sarah (White) Henson.

Adopted and raised by her aunt and uncle Johnie and Elbert Henson in Indianapolis, she graduated from Ben Davis High School in 1972. Gayle was the owner and teacher of Gold Star Dance Academy, located on the west side of Indy for twenty-eight years.

She worked for Morgan Hospital/IU Health in Martinsville, then transferred to Bloomington, before retiring this past April after twenty-seven years of service. The family moved to Martinsville in 1995.

Along with her birth parents, Gayle was preceded in death by her adopted parents Johnie and Elbert Henson; and siblings, Burl, Joe, Mike, Herb, Kenny, and Doyle Henson.

Gayle leaves behind her best friend and loving husband of forty-six years, Don Bodell of Martinsville; sons, Kyle (wife, Trish) of Mooresville, Kurt (wife, Chantel) of Mooresville, and Kris (wife, Mandy) of Indianapolis; siblings, Alvin, Ed, Dan and Steve Henson, Donna Wilder, Nora Brawner, Betty Davis and

Barb Wand; and beloved grandchildren, Brock, Bryce, Malina, Emma, Carter, and baby Liam who will enter the world sometime in March.

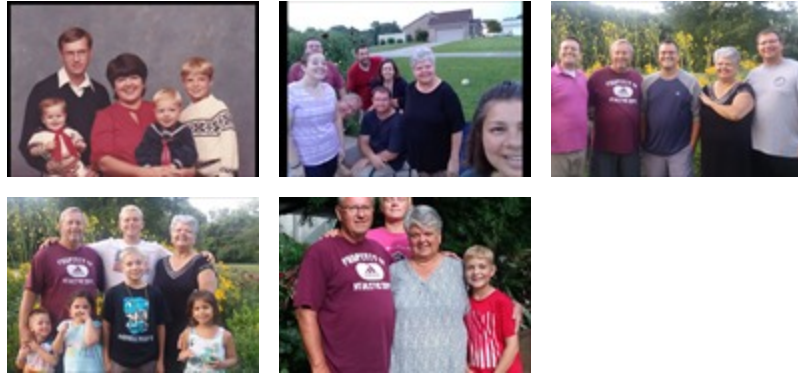
