Barbara Lou (Allen) Everett, 82, life-long Monrovia resident, was relieved of all debilitating ailments on Tuesday, March 8, 2022, with her most precious people at her bedside at Meadow Lakes in Mooresville. She was born in Martinsville, IN, on October 2, 1939, the only daughter to the late Jay and Cora (Ferguson) Allen.

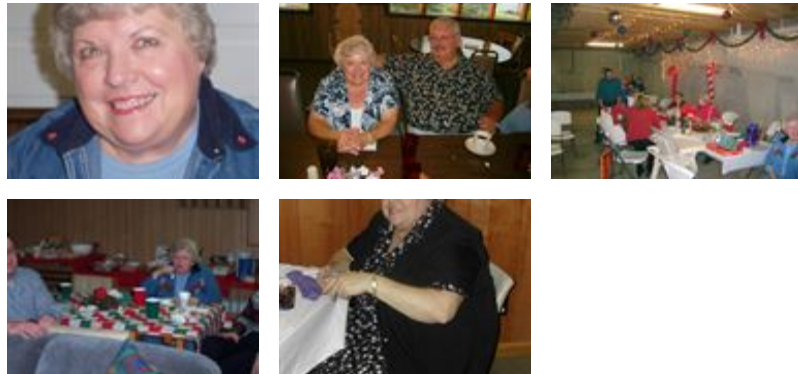
