Bernice (Clark) Williams Pieczko, 84, of Quincy, was called to Heaven at 7:30 pm, on Friday, October 25, 2019, while surrounded by loved ones in the comfort of her own home. She was born at home on March 1, 1935 in Black Oak, Arkansas to the late Homer and Blanch (Qualls) Clark.

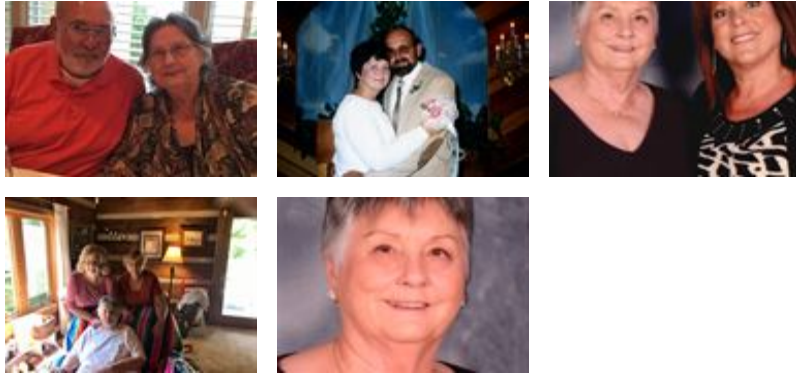
