Billy "Dale" Jackson, 61, of Indianapolis, passed from this life unexpectedly on December 28, 2020. He was born on June 14, 1959, in Beattyville, Kentucky to the late Billy C. Jackson and Geraldine (Riley) Hudgins, who survives.

The oldest of three children, Dale was raised in Kentucky, Indiana, and Illinois. His teenage years were spent in Easton, Illinois, where he proudly graduated with the class of 1978. 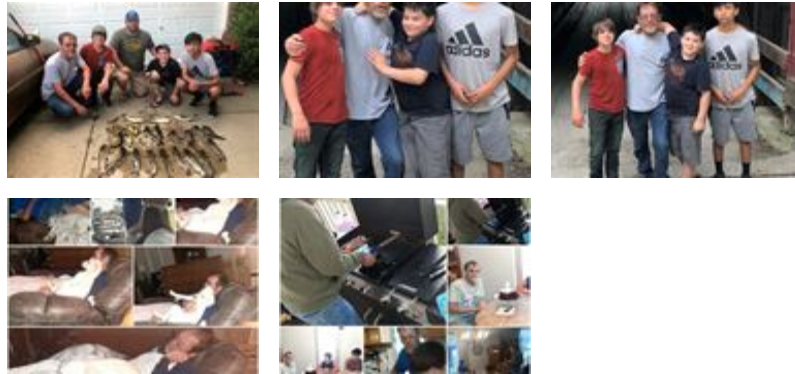
