



## Bradley "Brad" Sowers

July 17, 1981 - June 13, 2021

Bradley "Brad" W. Sowers, 39, of Monrovia, passed from this life on Sunday, June 13, 2021, after a brief illness while in the care of Sidney & Lois Eskenazi hospital. He was born in Martinsville on July 17, 1981, to Michelle (Sowers) Smith and Rodney E. Hall.

A proud Monrovia high school graduate, Brad continued his education at Lincoln Tech, where he learned to be a skilled diesel mechanic. He secured employment at the local TA truck stop and worked at several locations in the Indiana and Florida for 25 years.

As a young man at the tender age of 20, Brad packed his belongings and headed south to the tropical climate of Lakeland, Florida, where he met the girl of his dreams and future wife, Suzanne.
