Brenda Sue (Keller) Landis, 57, of Monrovia, beloved wife, mother, sister, and friend, was called to the end of a courageous seven year battle against lung cancer, in which she spent the last four years in remission before the cancer returned and led to her departure on Tuesday, April 30, 2024, in University Hospital, Indianapolis. Brenda was the third child born into a family of six, on February 21, 1967, in Sullivan, Indiana, to the late Donald and Shirley Ann (Worth) Keller.

Brenda graduated from Mooresville High School with the class of 1985 and studied cosmetology at Henry's Beauty College. Full of ambition, she was a talented and dedicated hairstylist; successfully owning and operating "Shear Illusions Beauty Salon" in Mooresville since October of 1994. Brenda's talent and passion for her work touched the lives of many. Her adventurous spirit led her to seek out new experiences and she found solace in the sunshine where her soul was most content with the waves and the sandy beaches of Madeira, Destin, and Panama. At first, she and Jeff splurged on a 1988 Donzi, where they made waves and memories. However, after two years, they decided to sell their Donzi for a brand-new 1997 Sea Ray. This decision turned out to be a worthwhile sacrifice, as it brought them immense joy. Taking the boat out to various destinations including, but not limited to: Lake Monroe, Dale Hollow Lake and most recently they would pack up the dogs and escape down to Lake Cumberland where they co-owned property and created many memories

with family and friends. She always loved her Classic Rock, and she loved many bands, such as Tesla, Boston, Foreigner, Buckcherry, and Kid Rock, just to name a few.

She was the rock of her family, providing strength and support to those around her. Her family was her world, and she poured her heart and soul into the work that she did. Known to keep Jake and his friends in line, Brenda kept an in-order home, and she held tight to the reins at all times. She and Jeff complemented each other perfectly, and they both worked tirelessly to create a beautiful life together. Brenda's memory will live on in the hearts of all who knew her, and she will be deeply missed by her family, friends, and the community she touched. Leaving behind a legacy of love, strength, and unwavering loyalty, Brenda was a shining inspiration in the lives of all who knew her. Her courage and determination were evident in every aspect of her life, as well as her unyielding love for her family. 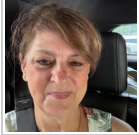
