Bryan Lee Acton, 51, resident of Wilbur, formerly Indianapolis, passed from this life at 12:05 a.m., on Sunday, September 16, 2018 after a brief and courageous battle with illness. He was born on November 20, 1966, in Indianapolis, to the late Jack Loren and Delores (Joyce) Acton.

A Harley Davidson loving, motorcycle and corvette enthusiast, Bryan was raised in Indianapolis and graduated from Manual High School in 1985.
