Charles E. "Chuck" Chestnut, 75, of Monrovia, passed away at 5:40pm, on Monday, August 22, 2016, in the comfort of his own home. He was born on June 17, 1941, in Indianapolis, to Ralph Quinten Chestnut and Georgia (Tingle) Rafferty.

After graduating from Washington High School in 1959, Chuck bravely enlisted in the United States Navy. He actively served his country until 1963. While enlisted, Chuck learned a trade and after being honorably discharged in 1965, he joined the Plumbers and Pipe Fitters Union #440. He married Susan Marie Sparks in 1971 and shared 32 years of marriage before her passing in 2003. A hardworking and dedicated man, Chuck faithfully provided for his family working in the union, where he retired from in 2003.

He was a member of the Martinsville American Legion, VFW and Riders. In addition, he belonged to the Eagles in Mooresville and also frequently visited the Legion and VFW. A jokester and man of his word, Chuck could spark up an interesting conversation with about anyone. An avid optimist, Chuck possessed an indescribable level of strength and courage. Never giving up, He managed to keep a positive outlook with chemo

and radiation treatments and bravely battled cancer for three years. Chuck was full of integrity, determination and lived life to the fullest.

He was preceded in death by his father, Ralph Chestnut and wife, Susan (Sparks) Chestnut.

Survivors include his children, Jeanie Chestnut of Monrovia and formerly of Jasonville, Kay Langdon of Kokomo and Chad Chestnut of Tennessee; soulmate and special friend, Linda Stinson of Mooresville; mother, Georgia Rafferty of Monrovia; sister, Sharon Ratts of Jamestown; grandchildren, Brandon, Dustin, Jessaka, Kenny, Lexus, Ethan and Paige; and 7 great grandchildren.
