Charolett Ann (Jones) Hood, 68, of Mooresville, passed away on Friday, April 5, 2024, after battling cancer from within the comfort of her own home and surrounded by family. Charolett was born on June 5, 1955, in Oliver Springs, Tennessee, to her loving mother, Mary Helen (Martin) Romans.

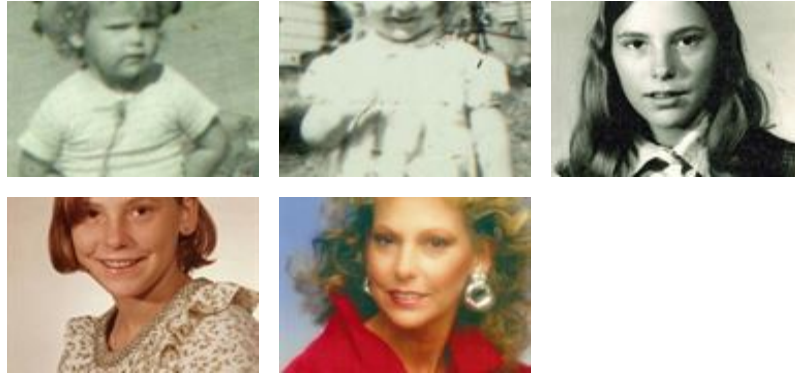
