Christine M. (Jones) Orr, 69, of Clayton, left this world unexpectedly and all too soon, entering the gates of Heaven on Tuesday, December 26, 2023, while in the comfort of her home. She was born in Barberton, OH on January 1, 1954, to the late Bill R. and Dina (Mort) Jones.

With a Romanian upbringing, Christine's family traveled frequently and when she was 7 years old, she met a boy named Clyde that she enjoyed playing with. The two hung out for 2 years before the families both moved away, and he couldn't find her until 8 years later. Finally reuniting but unable to date per the family's rule, he asked for her hand in marriage and the pair were happily united in marriage on September 5, 1971, bringing two beautiful daughters and a son into the world and spending 52 glorious years together. Starting their lives off fresh and with no money was challenging to say the least. They purchased a camper for a mere \$37 and moved to the city. Clyde worked 7 days a week scrimping and saving every dollar, so the couple were able to make a better life for their family, and they later settled in Hendricks County building their forever home.

A true music lover, Christine's favorite genre was reggae. She was a talented dancer and known to cut a rug at all events. A whiz in the kitchen, she was famous for her fried chicken, whipping up family dinners with enough food to feed an army, and it was guaranteed not a soul left her home hungry. She

found her quiet place riding her prized Bunton mower while listening to her favorite tunes on her ear buds. She enjoyed playing the slots at the casinos as well as on her phone, sipping beer from a glass the way a true lady does, and drinking Bloody Marys. Her TV ritual was to watch Gunsmoke, the Andy Griffith Show, Everybody Loves Raymond, followed by the news.

The hard work and dedication paid off for Christine and Clyde, enabling them to travel the world while lovin' life, and making friends everywhere they went, usually in a tiki bar on a beach in any given exotic place they found themselves. She loved her family dearly and was usually funny and always as feisty as a firecracker, rarely slowing down because she refused to waste time. She referred to Clyde as her hero since he saved her from any and every predicament that she managed to get herself into. Christine left a legacy of light and love for those who knew and loved her. She will be deeply and profoundly missed.

Along with her parents, she was preceded in death by her son Stanley Orr and grandson, Franky Orr.

Christine leaves behind her devoted husband, Clyde H.
