



Conrad Ratts

May 5, 1944 - June 16, 2026

Henry "Conrad" Ratts, 82 of Monrovia, passed away on Tuesday afternoon, June 16, 2026, while in the comfort of his own home. Born in Martinsville, Indiana, on May 5, 1944, Conrad was the son of the late Robert and Marie (Williams) Ratts.

Conrad grew up in the Hall area and graduated from Monrovia High School with the class of 1962, where he played on the baseball and basketball teams. A proud veteran, Conrad served his country in the National Guard out of Stout Field from 1966 to 1971. His commitment to his fellow veterans was a lifelong cornerstone, evidenced by his proud, 50-year lifetime membership with the American Legion Post 103 in Mooresville.

Conrad was a dedicated provider and a hard worker, successfully retiring twice in his lifetime. First, from Allison's after 33 years of dedicated service, and later retired from Adesa after 20 years, where he worked parking cars and as an equipment driver.

Known for his vibrant personality and love for the simple pleasures in life, Conrad enjoyed riding motorcycles and camping throughout the United States. A familiar face at the horse tracks and casinos, he always looked forward to popping a few tops and sitting down for a card game, especially poker. Conrad was also an avid coin collector, enjoyed relaxing with a cold

beer, and above all, cherished the time spent talking, laughing, and sharing stories with his close friends and family.

In addition to his parents, Conrad was preceded in death by his sister, Judith Dunham, and his nephew, Darin Dunham.

He is survived by his wife, Vena Alford-Ratts of Monrovia; daughter, Leigh Juliano (Joseph) of Mooresville; nephew, Chris Dunham; grandchildren, Joseph Michael Juliano of Tonawanda, New York, and Jessica McKinney (Seth) of Brownsburg; great-grandchildren, Kylie, Remington, Carson, and Wynn; along with a host of distant family members and lifelong friends.
