Damon J Martin, age 19, of Mooresville, was suddenly called to join his Papaw in Heaven, on Wednesday, April 7, 2021, in Hendricks County. Entering this world on a Tuesday, it was on May 22, 2001, that Amber (Donahue) and Tyler Martin, gave name to the 10.9 lbs. of perfection at St. Vincent Hospital in Indianapolis.

Having been the only child until the age of six, Damon kept his family on their toes and took his sweet time getting through the terrible twos. At six years old, his world forever changed when taking the role of Lylah's big brother. Primarily raised by his mother, Damon was above all his mother and sister's protector; to whom was inseparable, and both absolutely adored. Accustomed with transferring schools, Damon was a natural when it came to making friends. An outgoing, thoughtful, and selfless young man, he had a way of captivating the crowd and he loved nothing more than to be surrounded in the company of family and friends. With video games and online gaming at the top of his list, he played on the Bulldogs Varsity Football Team and was on the swim team at Tri-West. Having an eclectic taste in music, he liked to bump out the system and was partial to rap. An avid fan of the Florida Gators, his favorite color was that bright blue. Sharing an unbreakable brotherly bond with 19 cousins, they were a pack to keep under supervision and a force that was not to be crossed. Most proud to follow in his grandfather's footsteps, Damon bravely enlisted to serve in United States Marine Corps, where was discharged from training due

to an injury and was anxiously waiting to be cleared to return in August. With a great deal of potential and a world of possibilities ahead, it is beyond our own reasoning to find sense in the void that stands in his absence. Yet it is with a pure and golden heart, there was not a mean bone in Damon Martin's body, and he lived a life of peace and love. Laughing and loving throughout the end of his days, may the genuine concern and fun spirited nature shine on through the ages and honor his legacy. His charismatic spirit and radiating presence will be greatly missed.

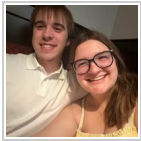
