Daniel Thomas Jones, 68, of Martinsville, was called to complete his earthly journey, passing from this life in the comfort of home, surrounded by his loving family at 8:31pm, on Thursday, November 18, 2021, due to pulmonary complications. He was born on July 21, 1953, in Clinton, Indiana to the late Robert Thomas Jones II and Ramona (Ford) Coulter.

Engrained to rise in adversity, Dan was the oldest of 5 siblings, stepping up to look out and care for the younger kids. Taking an interest to meet the new hillbilly girl that had roughed up her cousins, Dan and Cheryl started seeing each other at a young age. Unwilling to let her return to Kentucky, the two married on August 8, 1971, growing together as a team, continuously catering to each other's needs for over 50 years.

Enlisting to proudly serve his country with the United States Navy, Dan was loyal and genuine to the core. He was known to take in all strangers, stragglers, and friends of the kids. He was a wonderful father, a passionate protector, and diligent provider for his family. Dedicating 36 years as a job setter for Allison's Transmission, he utilized every opportunity to spontaneously turn a drive in or dinner trip into a vacation to Florida, adding to his collection of vehicles, be it bikes, trikes, truck, corvettes, or recreation vehicles. A man of his word, his presence was known, as was his ability to let you know where he stood. Growing softer with grandchildren, Dan was most

content when surrounding himself with all the kids. A jack of all trades, he was given the nickname Indiana Jones as he and Cheryl truly enjoyed going on rides, traveling to see the beauty of several different states.

He held previous memberships with clubs including Abate, Brothers of the Third Wheel, and most recently he liked to ride with Tri-addicts. Known for big purchases, he could get just about anything running and was continuously on the go. He took pride in his home and property, remodeling and adding as the years went by. Dan loved to celebrate the big moments. He would even plant a tree when the grandchildren were born and plant their family tree after Christmas. The family harvested their first two Christmas trees this year. A seize the moment and wild card type of guy, he loved music and especially rock n roll. A legacy of love and a genuine story to share with generations to come, the life of Dan Jones was an exemplary testament to a lifetime of authenticity and high morals. He lived to the fullest in his short 68 years, and his presence will forever be missed.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his younger siblings, Jerry Jones and Betty Zien.

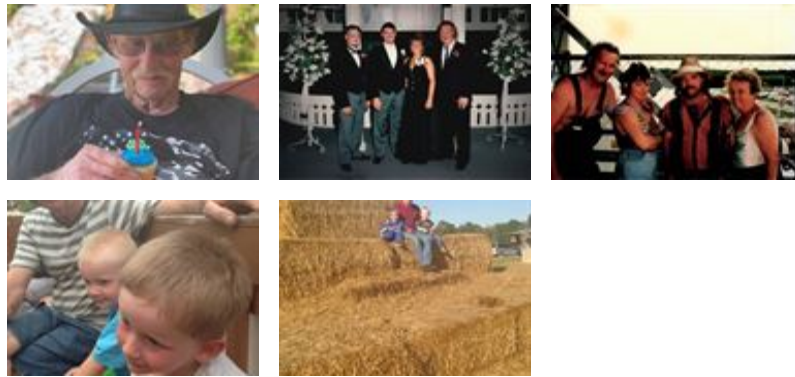
