March 21, 1953 - December 16, 2020

Danny Harold “Fish” Fisher, 67, of Fillmore, passed from this life, and gained his angel wings, on December 16, 2020, after a long battle with cancer. He was born in Beech Grove on March 21, 1953, to the late Harold L. and Barbara J. (Mayville) Fisher, who survives.

In his youth, Danny was raised one of three children in Rockville where he enjoyed skiing and boating on Raccoon Lake. After graduating with the class of 1972 from Ben Davis High School, he worked for Clayton Plastics Factory for several years, then for Bemis Company in Terre Haute, as a Machine Operator Engineer, until suffering from an industrial accident in 1988, that left him permanently disabled.

After a 26-year love affair, Danny married the love of his life, soulmate, best friend, and confidant, Glenna “Sunshine” Hartzell on October 15, 2020. The two knew each other for ten years before realizing they had developed a deep bond.

A member of the Hazelwood Christian Church, Danny surrendered his life to God and received baptism. A motorcycle enthusiast, he cherished his black and red Harley Davidson Heritage bike. He and Glenna frequently rode the countryside, enjoying nature’s beauty.

Well known and loved by many who were blessed to call him brother, Danny was a true-blue friend. Although he had a hard exterior, once cracked, he loved unconditionally and gave freely; never expecting anything in return. He had strong beliefs, and always looked at the world unbiased. A man of his word, and a genuine soul, he will be deeply missed.

Danny leaves behind his wife, Glenna Fisher of Fillmore; mother, Barbara Fisher of Greencastle; children, Lisa Pryor (David) of New Castle, and Heather Williams (Mark) of Greensburg; siblings, Steven Fisher (Candy) of Indianapolis and Jean Cannon (John) of Greencastle; grandchildren, Ashley Brown (Tyler) of New Castle and Kendera Downing of Greensburg; grandson, Keegan; along with several nieces and nephews.

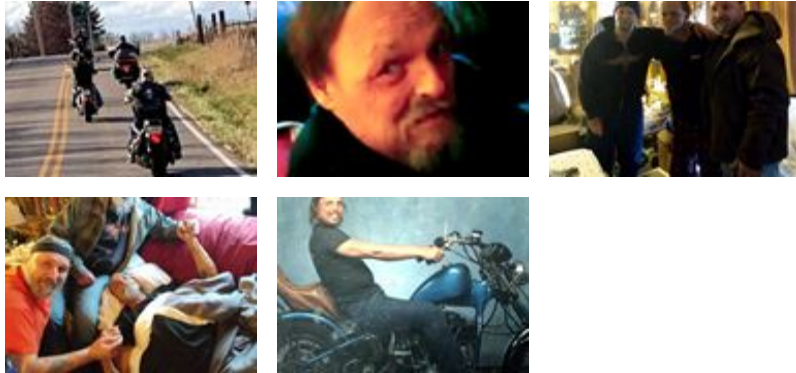
