Dennis “Denny” Lee Foreman, 75, of Indianapolis, passed peacefully from this life in the early morning hours of Wednesday, February 19, 2025, while in the comfort of his home. He was born in Indianapolis, on September 22, 1949, to the late Thomas and Lorene (Haywood) Foreman.

The oldest of three, and protective big brother, Denny graduated from Washington High School with the class of 1967 and proudly enlisted in the United States Air Force. Honest to the core and stubborn at times, he never knew a stranger and was known to strike up a conversation with anyone he crossed paths with. 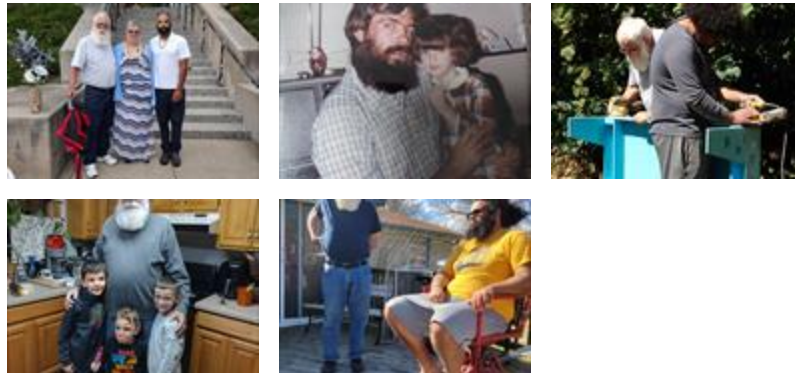

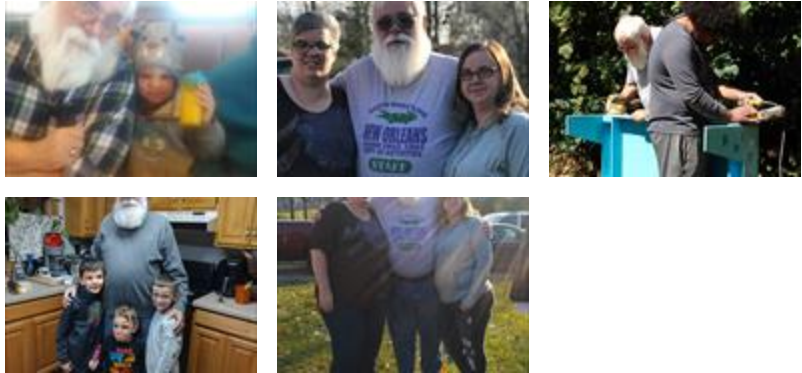

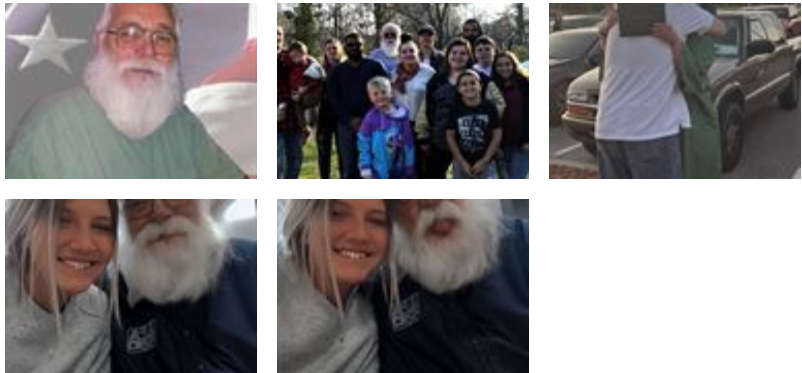
