



## Donald W. Allen

July 16, 1932 - July 11, 2022

Donald Ward Allen, 89, of Hazelwood passed away in the early morning hours on Monday, July 11, 2022, while in the care of Hendricks Regional Hospital. He was born in Indianapolis on July 16, 1932, to the late Horace H. and Flossie O. (Long) Allen.

After graduating from Monrovia High School with the class of 1950, Don attended Purdue University majoring in engineering. He married Patsy Hall on January 24, 1952, and they were married for 70 years. Living his entire life in the Monrovia/Hazelwood area, he supported many community activities. He worked 37 years at Allison Gas Turbine, retiring in 1990. He was active in the Hendricks County Republican Party and served as Precinct committeeman for 56 years. 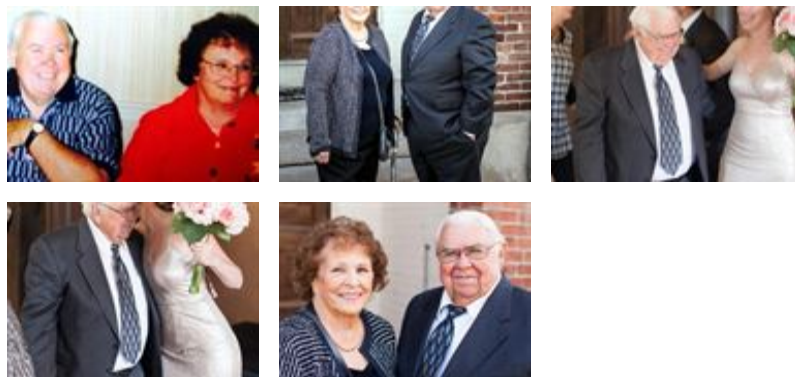
