Donald Allen Winters, 66, of Greenfield and formerly of Anderson, passed away on Saturday, September 30, 2017, in the Richard L. Roudebush VA Medical Center, Indianapolis. He was born on June 30, 1951, in Sacramento, California, to the late George and Pauline (Lindsay) Winters.

A native of California, Don briefly resided in Daviess, Kentucky. Shortly after his 18th birthday, he proudly enlisted to serve his country on July 23, 1969. 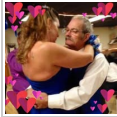
