Donaveeta “Donna” (Burton) Luedeman, 81, of Mooresville, was released of all earthly pain and called home to Heaven at 7:02 p.m., on Friday, June 15, 2018, while surrounded by loved ones and in the comfort of her own home. One of three daughters, she was born on December 19, 1936, in Connersville, to the late J. Lynn and Martha (Wyatt) Burton.

At the age of four or five, Donna moved to Indianapolis with her family and settled into a home on Sanders Drive. She attended school in Speedway and graduated with the class of 1954. Possessing an eccentric sense of humor and class, Donna had a radiant smile and was blessed with both beauty and wits. Previously affiliated with the local 893, Donna’s fun and vibrant demeanor allowed her to excel and blossom during her involvement in theatre, where she worked as a dresser in Broadway plays. She was strong and often referred to as the “rock” by family. She absolutely loved, loved, loved babies; especially her own; to whom she diligently raised with morals that were instilled by an understanding, forgiving and compassionate example. A selfless and devoted caregiver, Donna made certain that all five of her children were cared for while growing up.

Introduced later in life to the man that would become her best friend, Donna was beautifully blended into the Luedeman family on February 21, 1998; uniting in marriage with Robert “Bob” Luedeman, Sr. A dynamic duo, the two

shared similar interests, a love for family and an inseparable bond. Bob and Donna took pride in their home and enjoyed working together around the yard and planting flowers. Also, they enjoyed dancing, going on cruises, dressing up on Halloween, going out to eat, antiquing in various states, and watching plays. A great team, their personalities matched and whether they were teasing each other by hiding things around the house, they continuously supported and helped one another. Both intelligent, Donna used her secretarial skills to edit Bob's column for the newspaper. Always eager to play games and join in on the festivities, Donna and Bob valued family above all. Big on traditions, they were great holiday hosts and acquired lots of memories at cookouts with family and friends. Sadly, she was diagnosed with cancer in November and from there began a relentless battle. Although the world will never be same without her, Donna's family is grateful for the time that was shared on earth and comforted to know that she is free of pain and at rest; preparing for the reunion in Heaven.

Along with her parents, she was preceded in death by her son, Dennis Earle; grandson, Alex Foxworthy; and a great grandson, Jordan Spicer.

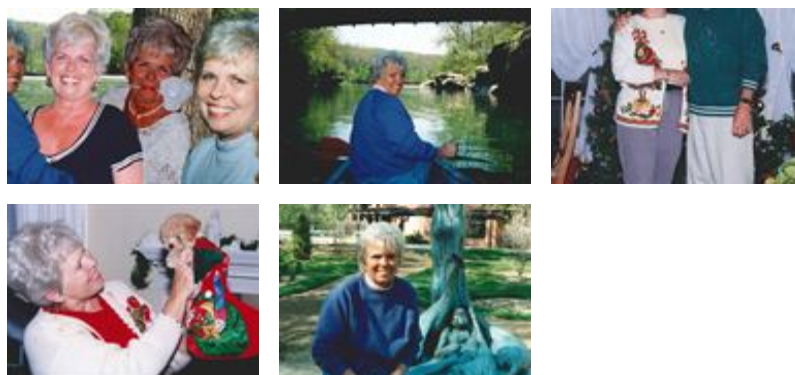
