Edith "Fran" White, 84, of Martinsville, formerly of Indianapolis, passed from this life on Wednesday, May 27, 2015, in St. Francis Hospital, Mooresville. She was born on December 5, 1930, in Crab Orchard, Kentucky, to the late Joseph and Lucy (Bryant) Hopkins.

Fran grew up in Lincoln County, Kentucky and moved to Indiana at the age of 10. After living in Crothersville and Lancaster, she settled in Indianapolis. A hardworking and patient mother to her five children, Fran provided for her family and worked at RCA for nearly 20 years as a press operator and later at Merry Maids. 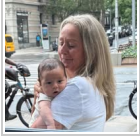
