A friendly and outgoing person, Eric was raised near Hall and attended Monrovia High School with the class of 2007. He was type of person who was known for giving the shirt off his back even if sometimes he needed to borrow it again for a little while. Eric's demeanor was warm, and he found joy in helping others. 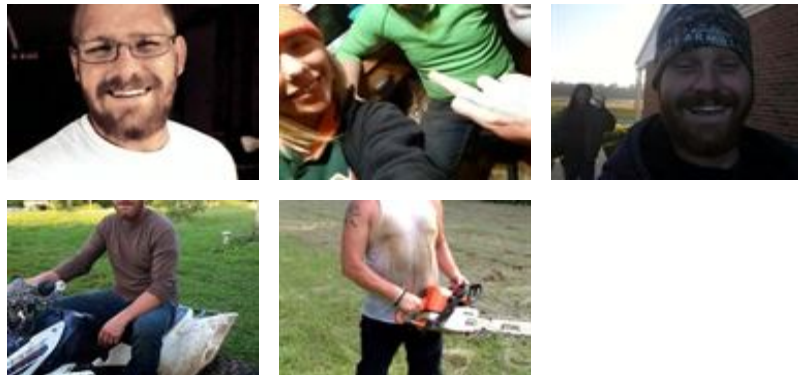

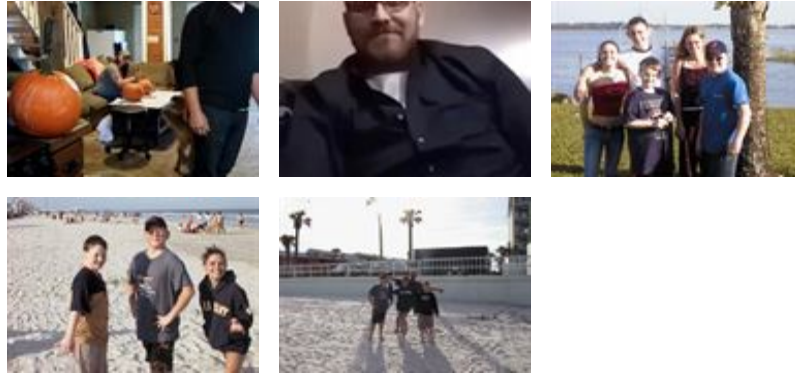
