Frank Andrew Belcher, 90, of Eminence, passed peacefully from this life on Sunday, October 16, 2022, while in the comfort of his home and surrounded by his large and loving family. He was born in Indianapolis on May 19, 1932, to the late James Clifford and Lena Lorene (Harper) Belcher.

One of seven children, Frank attended Ben Davis High School, spending his weekends at the local skating rink perfecting his moves. In his youth, the family packed their belongings and purchased farmland west of Monrovia where Frank and his siblings were instilled with a strong work ethic, managing the daily tasks of life on a farm. New to the country life, Frank found pleasure horseback riding, as well as cruising on motorcycles.

Securing his first job with McKelvey's Carpet as an installer, he was drafted into the United States Navy during the Korean War, proudly serving his country aboard the USS Macon CA 132 for two and a half years. Returning stateside, he was introduced to a pretty, young girl from Kentucky who instantly became the love of his life and soulmate, Thelma. With stars in their eyes and love in their hearts, the pair were joyously united in marriage on October 28, 1957.

A talented diesel mechanic, Frank was employed with several companies through the years, including Allison's Transmissions, Terrell Trucking, Ellis

Trucking, Four Star Transportation, before retiring from the Morgan County Highway department just nine years ago. Innovative by nature, he invented the first berm roller, winning the state award. A lifetime member of the VFW Post 1111, he was also a past member of the Fraternal Order of Eagles in Mooresville.

The family traveled yearly for vacations from Virginia Beach to Florida, the Grand Canyon, and Yellowstone Park. A stellar father and husband, Frank passed along his knowledge to his children, ensuring they would be self-sufficient and independent in life. Forever in love with his one and only, he often said he loved Thelma as much as the first day he met her, continuously ensuring her every need or want was met. A brave, tough patriarch, he was truly a man of honor, holding his family high above all else. He will be forever missed.

Along with his parents, Frank was preceded in death by his son, Bruce Belcher, and siblings Joan Fisher and Ronald O. Belcher.

He leaves behind his wife of 64 years, Thelma Marie (Best) Belcher of Eminence; children, Andy Belcher (Sandy) of Eminence, Lisa Barnett (David) of Eminence, Keith Belcher (Barb) of Camby, and Stephen Belcher (Danetta) of Eminence; siblings, Jim Belcher (Sue) of DeBary, FL, Bob Belcher (Susie) of Monrovia, Jean Bray of Monrovia, and Wanda Robbins (Jim) of Carmel; along with 21 grandchildren, 38 great grandchildren, 8 great great grandchildren, and 23 nieces and nephews, as well as his beloved furbaby, Marley.
