Grace A. Dooley, 84, of Knightsville and formerly of Indianapolis and Rockville, was released of all earthly ailments endured with a seven-year battle of Alzheimer's Disease. Comforted by two of her loving daughters (Jenny and Kimberly), Grace passed away at 10:25am, on Thursday, November 9, 2017, in Cloverleaf Healthcare. She was born on September 25, 1933, in Indianapolis, to the late Alan and Gladys (Mayhem) Waters.

Accustomed and prematurely instilled with motherly instincts, Grace assisted her mother in caring for her ten siblings. Survivors include her children, Danny Dooley (wife, Carla) of Washington State, Terrie Long of Rockville, Hubert Dooley (wife, Hedi) of Marshall, Pat Dooley (wife, Holly) of Indianapolis, Jenny Dooley Lee of Monrovia and Kimberly Jones of Marshall; one brother, Jim Waters of Wilbur; 15 grandchildren and many great grandchildren.


