



## Harald H. Reindorf

August 17, 1953 - July 6, 2021

Harald Heinz Reindorf, 67, of Mooresville, passed from this life after a brief illness on Tuesday, July 6, 2021, at University Hospital in Indianapolis. He was born in Templehoff, West Germany on August 17, 1953, to the late Edna Ilse Selbman and Heinz Johannes Sonntag, later adopted by Lothar Reindorf after arriving in the U.S.A. at the tender age of 5.
