



Harry D. Cloud

January 7, 1949 - February 18, 2024

Harry Douglas Cloud, 75, of Mooresville, passed peacefully from this life in the early morning hours of Sunday, February 18, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. He was born in Indianapolis on January 7, 1949 to the late Anna B. (Boenkamp) and Frank G. Sublett.

A Mooresville native, Harry was a 1967 graduate from Mooresville High School. Immediately following graduation, he proudly enlisted in the United States Navy to serve his country during the Vietnam War as a talented Machinist Mate on the Submarine U.S.S. Patrick Henry and was also a Blue Nose in the arctic. Upon his honorable discharge, Harry went to work at the Hendrick's County Sheriff's Department as a police officer, later gaining employment with Allison Transmission as a man known to have the innate abilities to tackle any job given, dedicating 42 years of service, and deservingly retiring in 2019.

Meeting the pretty and feisty woman, Jacqueline, while at work who he would eventually marry, Harry managed to woo her in with his charm and the pair were married on February 14, 1982 in Indianapolis and spent 42 glorious years together.

A member of Indiana Freemasons, Lodge #669, he was also a volunteer firefighter for Brown Township Fire Department from 1972 to 1982 and served

as assistant Fire Chief for two years. In the 1980s, Harry served on the board, playing an integral role, aiding in the startup of Life Star Ambulance Service in Mooresville. He also was a volunteer EMT on the ambulance service, with his wife, Jacqueline, in the 1980s.

Harry loved boating, camping, traveling, and especially spending time with his family. He knew no stranger and would strike up a friendly conversation wherever he went. With a wealth of knowledge, he was gifted with the ability to fix almost anything. Selfless by nature, he would help anyone in need and would give the shirt off his back if he thought someone needed it more than he did. He loved unconditionally and deeply. His deep voice and beaming smile will be forever missed by all who were blessed to know him.

Harry leaves behind his wife, love of his life, and soulmate, Jacqueline Cloud of Mooresville; two sons, Marc (Laura) Cloud of Mooresville, Mark Hammonds of Mooresville, and daughter Lynn (Doug) Weathers, of Greenwood; brother-in-law, Randy Belcher of Mooresville; six grandchildren, Aaron Hammonds, Morgan Tinnon, Curtis Cloud, Kyle Cloud, Kadin Weathers, and Destiny Weathers; and three great-grandchildren, Isabella Negri, Addison Parris, and Gavin Tinnon.
