September 20, 1950 - February 1, 2019

Huston Leonard “Pete” Hall, 68, of Indianapolis, was called to heaven at 5:56 p.m. on Friday, February 1, 2019 while surrounded by loved ones, within the comfort of his own home. He was born on September 20, 1950, in Beech Grove, to the late Reed and Lovie Estelle (Lynn) Hall Bryant.

During his adolescence, Huston spent the summer months in Kentucky with his grandma and grandpa Lynn where he was blessed to share special memories and acquire many life lessons. It was during one of those visits that he was given the nickname Hoosier Pete which was shortened to Pete and continued by the family. Huston grew up in Indianapolis and attended Arsenal Tech with the class of 1968. After high school he pledged to love and cherish a girl that lived down the street and was united in marriage with Pam Sizemore on November 2, 1968. A meticulously disciplined and determined man, he went to work for RCA then General Motors (Chevrolet) before entering route sales with Malone & Hyde and later served as the assistant manager for AutoZone for many years. Huston also prepared and filed returns at H&R Block for 25 years as tax season was said to be his most enjoyable time of year.

Mr. Hall was a man that was fueled with conviction and belief to follow a selfless desire to solve and achieve while he assisted others by helping to build and save with financial decisions. Whether it was taking the filing lead on

preparing personal tax returns within his division or reworking the church's financials as the deacon to remodel the chapel roof, his power to deliver was achieved when his mind was fully invested. Above all, his life was derived on faith and his world revolved around his family. Known for taking things to the next level, Huston never failed at professing his love and adoration with unique and clever surprises. In addition to accomplishing things that some can only dream, he enjoyed listening to gospel and country music and was an avid collector of many things including classic model cars, coins and pens. Partially prone to the traditional nature, he did not like the idea of change and to prevent the fear of running out, he often purchased not one, but two or three of the same items; especially when finding his go to attire, a short-sleeve blue plaid shirt. An outgoing, friendly and busy man, he most recently drove the IUPUI shuttle bus but was forced to medically retire in June of 2018. A man of mind, body and spirit, the life of Huston "Pete" Hall was lived full of love and laughter therefore his legacy leaves an example to lead especially for the loved ones that he has left behind. He was deeply cherished and will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Larry Hall; half-brother, Danny Bryant and great granddaughter, Mackenzie Wilson.

Survivors include his best friend and loving wife of 50 years, Pam (Sizemore) Hall of Indianapolis; son, Huston "Lee" Hall (wife, Kimberley) of Mooresville; adored daughter, Kimberly Roberts (husband, Thomas) of Indianapolis; sister, Ellen Sue Miller (husband, Blackie) of Indianapolis; grandchildren, Kassandra Wilson (husband, Donnie), Kaylee Neely (husband, Aaron), Madison and Thomas Roberts along with Huston "Davis" Hall; great grandchildren, Clayton Wilson, Abeleine Neely and Donovan Wilson.

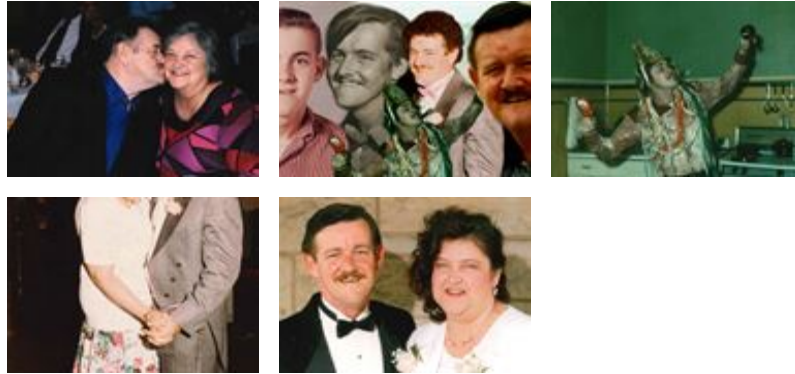

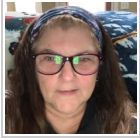

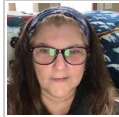
