continuously boisterous, he was never afraid to be himself-take him or leave him, but we all took him into our hearts. A man of faith, he attended the Crossroads Church in Avon. Above all, he deeply loved his family and always wanted the best for his children. Leaving this world too soon, he will be forever missed.

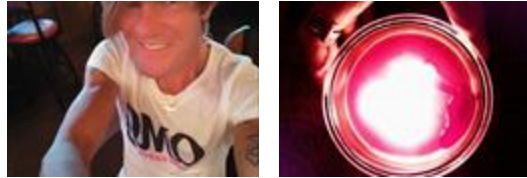
