November 25, 1992 - June 25, 2021

Jayson Kyle Hamilton, age 28, of Morgan County, was tragically killed in a fatal car-on-bike collision on Friday, June 25, 2021, after finishing his shift from work near the 39 bypass on State Road 67.

Jayson was a happy, smart, and loveable person. Making friends most everywhere that he went, he attended grade school at Poston Road Elementary, then transferred to Owen Valley and went to high school at Mooresville. An intelligent, sensitive, and friendly person, he made sure that his people knew that they were special by always saying, "I Love You." Currently employed at the Martinsville Wendy's, Jayson had been there two months and previously worked at the Martinsville and Greencastle McDonalds. Partial to shine with creativity and an artistic talent, he was very good at drawing, and he tastefully used a few tattoos and piercings that were unique to his own style and life story. Never straying too far from family, Jayson had no shame in being a momma's boy and he was true to stand in and take up for all who blessed to share in his circle of loved ones. His favorite professional sports teams included the Chicago Bulls and Pittsburgh Steelers. Drawn to the color of red, he liked to listen to all genres of music and his most favorite snack was baby bell cheese. His welcoming presence and goofy nature will forever be missed. Now Gone, yet never forgotten, his legacy and memory now shines behind the eyes of all who carry him in their hearts.
