August 9, 1940 - September 11, 2021

Mrs. Carolyn “Jean” Everett, 81, of Monrovia, was called to cross into heaven at 5:25pm, on Saturday, September 11, 2021, with loved ones warming the bedside of Franciscan Heart Hospital on Emerson Ave.

One of three children, she was born on August 9, 1940, in Paris, Illinois, to the late Carl Stewart and Opal Pearl (Williams) Stewart Oden, where she attended Zionsville High School and graduated with the class of 1958. Previously working as a stenographer and bookkeeper, Jean wore many hats through her life and if she was in control then the job was done right. Living on the Elsworth Air Force Base while George was in the service, they were blessed with two sons and moved back to settle into Monrovia where they purchased farm ground near the Morgan and Hendricks County lines. Raising the kids in Monrovia, Jean was a saint and slayer; laying the law to see her three boys turn into three great men. An excellent cook with her specialty being fried foods, dinner was religiously served at 6:00 to those in attendance and there was a home cooked meals on the table every night.

Standing at the gates and present at the pulls in her younger years, Jean avidly worked to keep a clean house raise the kids and rule the roost while George pulled on the road with the hogs and worked nights at the truck stop. Jean was a say what you mean, stand your own ground - serve it up straight kind of gal. With grandkids and family being her life, her and George were

blessed to Celebrate 61 years of marriage in April of 2021.

A few of Jean's achievements and various involvements include the Monrovia Bookstore, the Girls Softball League, and the Monrovia Festival she helped or did get them started. A familiar face at the Monroe-Gregg School Districts, while the kids were in School Jean worked the bookstore, then before taking secretarial position at Hall Elementary, along with avidly cheering and supporting three boys and nine precious grandchildren through their Bulldog careers of little league teams, varsity games, meets and matches, concerts, farming, 4-H and many Tractor pulls that she faithfully worked and sat in attendance. Along with in 1978, Mrs. Jean started her career with the United States Post office and it was there that she dedicated 20 years working with her old pal, Ms. Katie Tucker Paskett. After retiring in 2000, Jean and Katie got their social fix working part-time for the Church family when Dawghouse was in the old Methodist Church building.

A legend in her own time, Jean took part in planning of the festival and parade for Monrovia where Sunday marked the 37th year and anniversary that she so generously shared her time and talent to leading the Monrovia Festival and Civic Association. Jean was a diligent euchre player and a huge fan of Elvis. She will be missed by many and remembered by all who loved her.

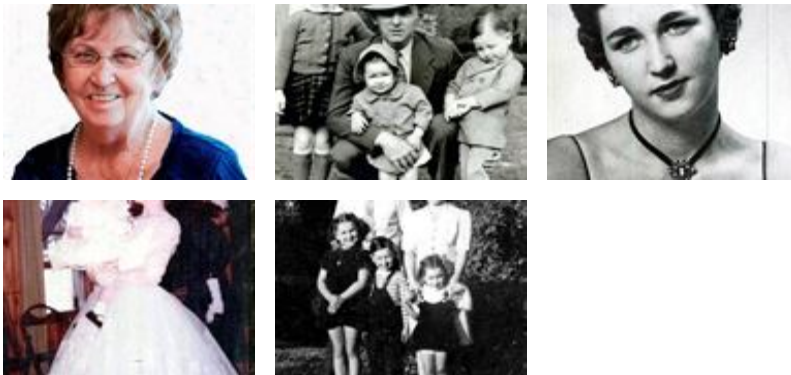
