Jerry D. Benefiel, 74, of Greenwood, passed from this life on Friday, June 22, 2018, in Greenwood Health & Rehab. The youngest of six children, he was born in Elwood, on April 18, 1944, to the late Wayne L. and Winifred C. (Barrett) Benefiel.

A 1962 graduate of Anderson High School, Jerry honorably served his country in the United States Army. A past member of the UAW Local #211, he was a reputable employee at General Motors for many years, where he deservedly retired on January 1, 1997. His current memberships include the Indianapolis American Legion Post #0711 and Our Lady of the Greenwood Catholic Church.

Known for telling stories and sharing history, Jerry was quick to engage in conversation and had a knack for socializing. With a mix of fate and a splash of luck, his life became sweeter in the early autumn of 1973. Pursuing a woman that he met on a blind date, smooth-talking Jerry just needed a few months before he was united in marriage with Patricia (Brady) Bowles. Entrusting his hand and entire heart to Pat, he eagerly converted to Catholicism and along with his daughter, he became the proud and loving father to all four of his children.

Possessing an outgoing, friendly, fun and happy demeanor, he was

passionate about animals, nature and he embraced the outdoors. Although he was an experienced jokester and excelled in the department of teasing and tormenting, Jerry Benefiel was a humble man who laughed often and never frowned. He was deeply loved by his family and he will be greatly missed.

Along with his parents, he was preceded in death by his son, Greg Bowles Benefiel and brothers, Don, Bob, Jack and Melvin Benefiel.

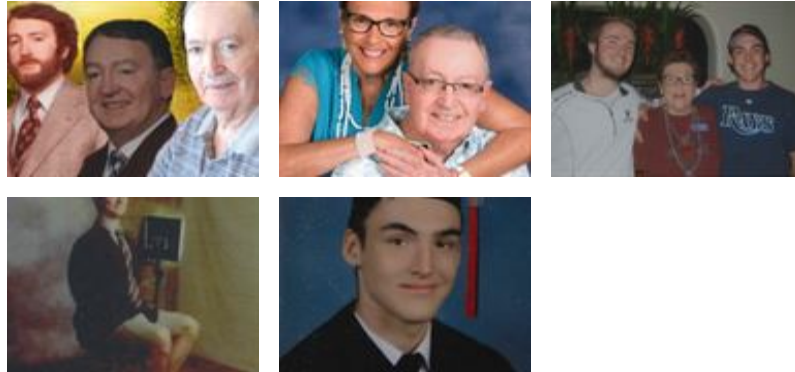
