Jerry Lee Gott, Jr., 64, of Eminence, was called to cross into the gates of Heaven while comfortably napping at home on Saturday, July 17, 2021. A fellow member and friend within the Eminence community and brotherhood of the Mid-West Motorcycle Club and Masonic Lodge #440 of Eminence. One of the five Gott children to grow up in Eminence, Jerry was born on August 24, 1956, to the late, Jerry Sr. and Patricia (Moorefield) Gott, who survives.

Jerry graduated with the class of 1973 and wound up in Las Vegas, for a little over decade where he held various positions in casino security, bouncing and personal bodyguard. Returning home, he entered the trucking industry where he was at Kenworth and Palmer Trucks before accepting his ailments and entering early retirement. Jerry above all loved his family, his little poodle companion, Boo, and he was loyal to all whom he was able to form a connection with. Along with his father, Jerry was preceded in death by his siblings, Cathy, Dennis, and Bill Gott, along with his fur baby Boo.
