Jill Dee (Schmalfeldt) Olar, 82, of Monrovia, passed peacefully from this life in the early morning hours on Tuesday, August 9, 2022, while in the comfort of her home and surrounded by her loving family. She was born in Connersville, IN, on February 16, 1940, to the late Hubert Henry and Ada Maxine (White) Schmalfeldt.

Raised in the rural country life of Connersville, Jill was the second child of six, holding a special bond with all her brothers and sister and especially a unique bond with her older brother Jack (Jack and Jill). The kids spent their summers assisting on their aunt and uncle's farm, learning the lessons of hard work and dedication. A proud graduate from Connersville High School, Jill was a devoted single mother of two young daughters, securing employment with RCA while her girls were young. Moving on from RCA to BALKAMP to advance her career, she not only moved up, but she also met her future husband, Greg, a fellow co-worker. Smitten with her beauty, he asked her to accompany him to a local hockey game. The pair dated for five years before vowing their forever love on July 31, 1981.

A die-hard Jeff Gordon fan Jill took an early interest in his career, first following him in the Sprint and Midget Car Series, until he began racing NASCAR. Hooked from the start, she and Greg traveled the eastern United States with their camper, attending ten races a year for twelve years. Upon

retirement from Target as Jewelry Sales Associate in 2000, and with a yearning for the life in the country, the couple sold their camper and bought their forever home west of Monrovia. Continuing their love of travel, they visited Australia, took a cruise to Bermuda, along with daring to ride in a hot air balloon for her husband Greg's birthday,

Untamed in her youth, Jill was adventurous, energetic, and fun loving, riding her 350 Honda Motorcycle out west, bringing back a six-foot pair of bull horns strapped to the front of the bike. She enjoyed listening to country music, playing volleyball and softball, continuously keeping up with her adored grandchildren and then great grandchildren. Known for her green thumb, she planted and tended many flowerbeds around her home. Not only was Jill a loving and dedicated mother she was also their friend, endlessly worrying about their well-being. Above all she cherished her family deep in her heart, especially her beloved grandchildren and great grandchildren who they followed their activities after they mellowed out in their later years. Jill would usually have a cowbell at sporting events and her daughter, Tracie, hopes that you would think of mom when you hear one. She will be truly missed by all who knew and loved her. She was the life of the party and there was never a dull moment when she was around.

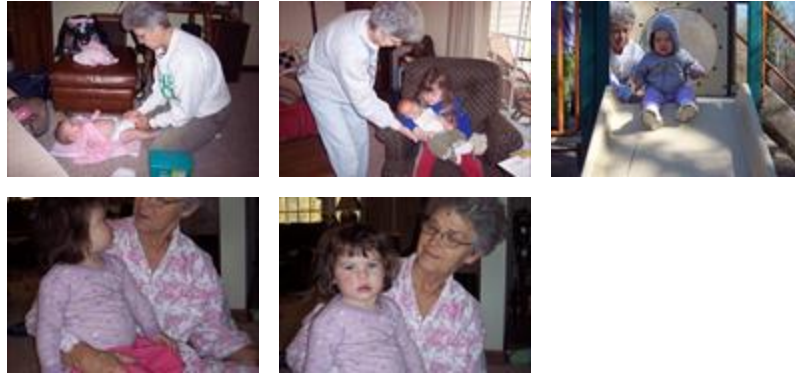

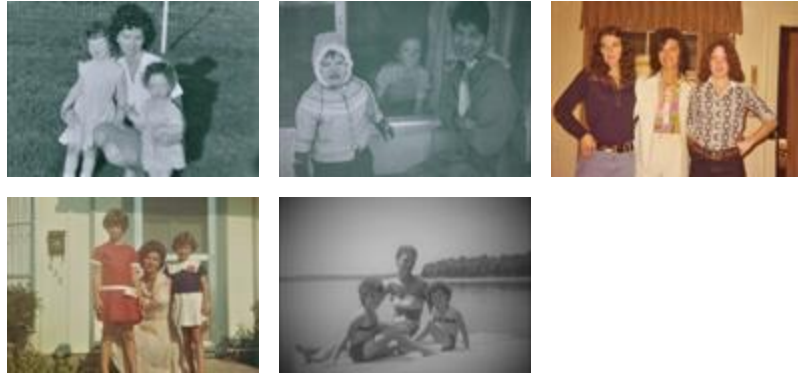

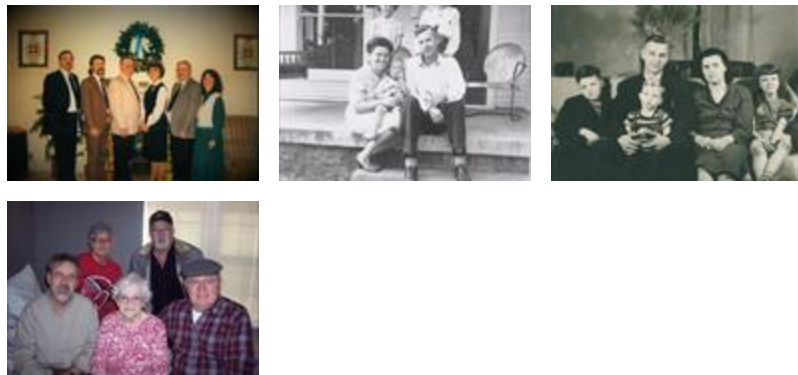
