



## Jim Hirschert

November 7, 1962 - January 18, 2025

James A. Hirschert, 62, of Martinsville, reached the end of his earthly journey on Saturday, January 18, 2025, in Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis. He was born on November 7, 1962, in Chadron, Nebraska, to the late William and Marion (Martin) Hirschert.

Living in Nebraska, Minnesota, and Oklahoma, as a child, Jim's family finally settled in Indiana where he graduated from Plainfield High School in 1981. He then went on to earn his associate's degree from ITT Technical Institute and secured employment with MASCO; working as a master installer of insulation for the next 25 plus years.

Above all, Jim was funny, stubborn, and his adventurous spirit has forever left its mark on the world and in the hearts of all who he knew and loved.
