John W. Quinn, 53, lifelong resident of Cartersburg, passed peacefully from this life on Saturday, August 17, 2024 while in the comfort of his own home. He was born in Danville, IN on June 20, 1971, to the late James Wesley and Marjorie Fern (Jackson) Quinn.
