Julie P. “Jules” Schumake, 41, of Indianapolis, gained her wings in heaven at 11:06 a.m., on Thursday, October 4, 2018, in Bethany Village Nursing and Health Care, after courageously battling Hodgkin's lymphoma and Wegener's. She was born on July 2, 1977, in Beech Grove, to Robert E. and Marilyn (Taylor) Schumake.

A 1996 graduate of Triton Central High School, Julie attended Indiana Business College and received a bachelor's in accounting from Indiana Institute of Technology. A vibrant, outgoing, compassionate and caring woman, her warm presence was welcoming and a contagious laugh that brought joy to those around her. Forced to fight Hodgkin's lymphoma at age 21, she bravely beat all odds and entered remission. Enduring more health complications than most, she still managed to selflessly keep everyone's best interest. Above all, she valued family and she adored children and animals. Always thinking of others, Julie strived to provide compassionate care to everyone around her; stepping up to the plate as Momma J for her boyfriend's children and taking in several stray cats and giving them names like Brewster, Kitty-Kat, Tori, Tiffany, Roxie and a dog, Keisha. Julie was easy to talk to and she developed several close relationships with former co-workers at IMI and Availity. Some of her hobbies included riding motorcycles, going to concerts, cooking, baking and annually attending the bubble run in Indianapolis. Definitely a glass half full type of person, at the end of every day she counted

her blessings and allowed the good to outweigh the bad. Six years ago, her life was given purpose, when God allowed her to become a mommy and granted her with a miracle baby, Reese. A beautiful soul, Julie's memory will forever remain with all of those that she touched along her brief yet meaningful journey.

She was preceded in death by her father, Robert E. Schumake and a beloved niece, Jordan Schumake.

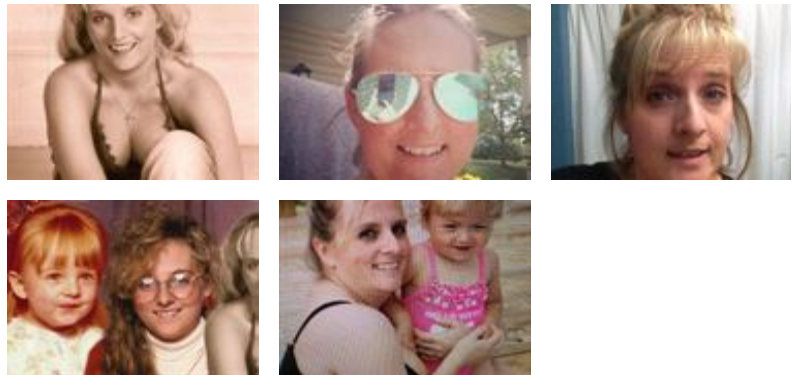
