Karen Ellen (Reeves) Dunigan, 67, of Wilbur, was freed from the burden of living with frontotemporal dementia and at last granted eternal peace at 9:55 pm on Wednesday, February 11th, 2026. The oldest of three children, Karen was born on May 18, 1958, in Indianapolis, to the late Joseph Bryan, Sr. and Rita Ellen (Elliott) Reeves.

A proud graduate from Monrovia High School with the class of 1976, Karen was an enthusiastic cheerleader. She met her future husband, Greg, while still in school and the pair hit it off instantly. They were united in marriage on May 22, 1976, at St. Thomas More Catholic Church, where Karen was a devoted member. The pair brought three upstanding children into their union, completing the family of five.

A devoted and excellent mother, Karen was a true nurturer, ensuring her kids were well taken care of, although the boys were known to test her patience with their boyhood shenanigans. A lifelong member of the Hoosier Nation, Karen was enthusiastic to cheer on Indiana University which earned her the title "IU Grandma."

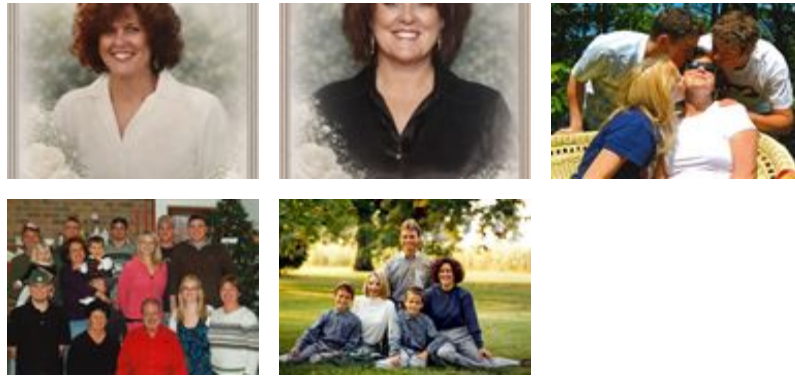
