Linda Mitchell, 69, lifelong resident of Morgan County and most recently of Camby, went to her heavenly home on Thursday, February 11, 2016, after a courageous battle with cancer. She was born on September 29, 1946, in Martinsville, to the late Julius Marvin and Joy Mae (Davis) Deem.

Linda graduated from Monrovia High School in 1964 and married Vaughn Neil Mitchell on April 8, 1968. She worked in the hotel industry for many years and also was a homemaker.
