Nathan Alan Hunter Sutherland, 4 years old, of Bloomington, left this world to be with the angels after a devastating drowning accident at his home, on Tuesday evening, April 21, 2015. The son of Grant Stephen “Stevie” Sutherland and Melissa “Missy” Ann (Hayden) Bernard, was born November 10, 2010, on opening day of shotgun season, where his second middle name Hunter came into place.

This bright eyed and active little firecracker started walking at ten months old. He was a walker, not a talker, always having somewhere to go. He loved the outdoors and was riding a bike without training wheels at the age of three. He loved all animals, especially monkeys. He was taught love, joy and responsibility through his cherished pets: a rabbit named Baby, guinea pig named Fred, cat named Monroe, and two dogs named Dottie and Gizmo.

Like all boys his age, Nathan enjoyed monster trucks, airplanes, Spiderman and Sponge Bob; if he could sit still long enough. Full of love for everyone and everything, he would always tell his mom and dad, “I Love You to the Moon and Back Again.” He was daddy’s boy to the core, but cared deeply for his bubby, mommy and sissy always telling them to, “Be Careful.” Nathan was their little “Tater-Tot” and “Piggy.”

His outgoing, spontaneous, and contagious smile will forever hold a place in

the hearts and memories of many. He touched so many lives in some small way throughout his short, yet memorable life. That gentle, yet sometimes mischievous smile would melt and instantly won the hearts of those around him.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather, Grant Alan Sutherland, to whom he will be laid to rest beside.

Along with his loving parents, Stevie and Missy of Bloomington, survivors include his brothers, Steven Sutherland and D.J.
