Norman Dale Ratts, 76, of Martinsville, entered into the presence of his Lord and Savior at 7:40 am on Tuesday, December 17, 2019. He was welcomed into heaven as a good and faithful servant who had fought the good fight and completed the race set before him. He was born on December 20, 1942 in Martinsville, to James and Elizabeth (Williamson) Ratts, his arrival completing their family.

Norman graduated from Monrovia High School in 1963. He joined the U.S. Air Force the following December, and proudly served his country for four years. He worked 33 years for Indianapolis Power & Light, retiring in 2000. A hard worker and good provider for his family, he would finish his shift at the plant and spend his evenings pursuing his life-long love of farming; a passion he passed on to his son.

A faithful and Godly man, Norman was a member of the Mt. Pleasant Christian Church in Hall for more than 60 years. He served as a Deacon, Elder, and Trustee. He taught the same Sunday school class as his mother before him.

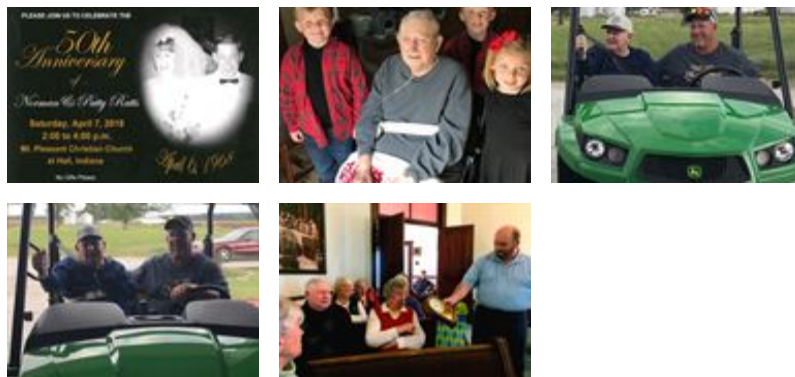
