Along with her parents, Patti was preceded in death by her brother, Steve Beverly.

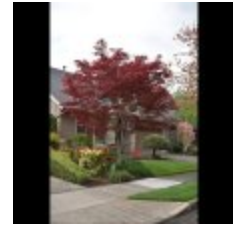
