



## Patrick M. Aleman

May 18, 1955 - October 28, 2016

Patrick Michael Aleman, 61, of Fishers/Greenfield and formerly of Minnesota, suddenly and unexpectedly passed from this life on Friday, October 28, 2016, in Community Heart & Vascular Hospital, after enduring a massive heart attack at work on Thursday evening. He was born on May 18, 1955, in Indianapolis, to the late Ignatay and Jacqueline (Soto) Aleman.

A 1973 Scecina graduate and US Air Force Veteran, Patrick grew up on the eastside of Indianapolis. After being honorably discharged from the Armed Forces in 1976, he relocated to Minnesota and started a family in Rochester. His life was devoted to God and solely based around church, work, family, grandchildren and spending time with good friends. In May of 2015, Patrick moved back to Indiana. His positive, fun-loving nature and free spirited demeanor will be deeply missed here on this earth.

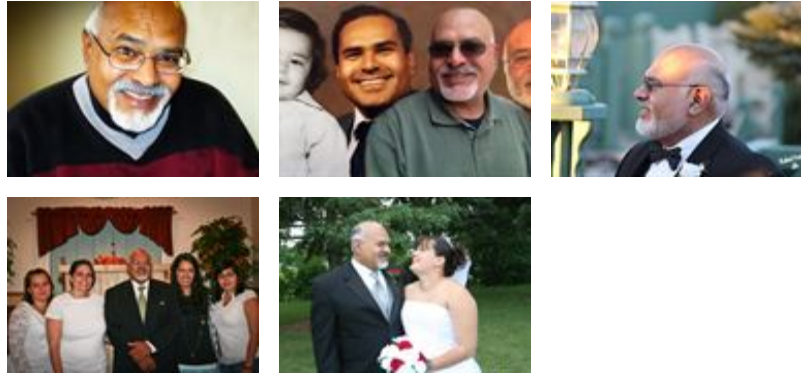
