Respected members of Gregg Township, Peggy and Jack donated acreage to the Mt. Pleasant Cemetery from their farm. She enjoyed knitting, crocheting, drawing, and was an avid reader. Peggy also liked to travel and looked forward to annual family vacations, most of which were car trips out West. Her life was lived to the fullest and even to her last day on earth, she remained self-sufficient and happy. Possessing a friendly smile and a heart of gold, Peggy was truly one of a kind and an absolutely wonderful wife, mother, sister, grandma and friend.

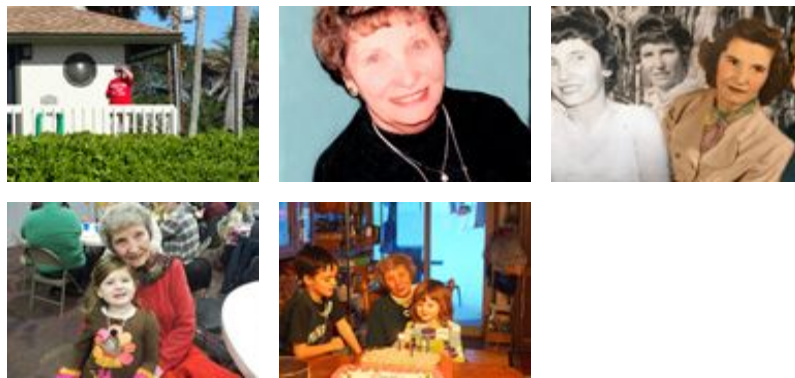
