Randy Lee Storm, 67, of Martinsville and formerly of Monrovia, passed peacefully from this life in the comfort of his own home and surrounded by his loving family on Wednesday, February 28, 2024. He was born in Lebanon, IN on January 14, 1957, to the late Albert and Gloria Dorthea (Daw) Storm.

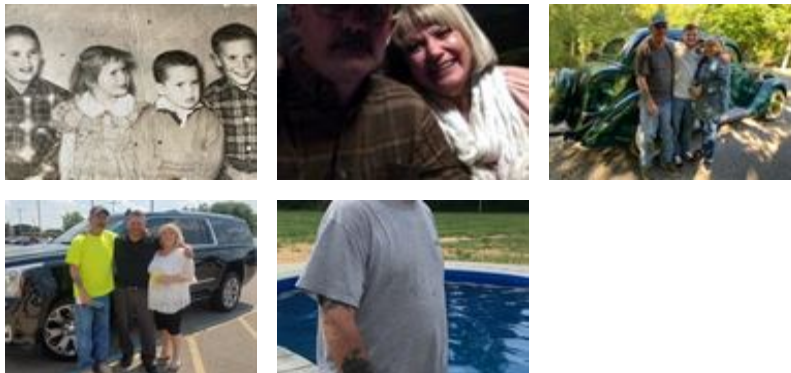
