



Robbie Ray Mullins

June 12, 1933 - December 17, 2016

Robbie Ray Mullins, 83, of Mooresville, passed from this life at 4:45am, on Saturday, December 17, 2016, in the comfort of his daughter's home. One of eight children born to the late, Ray and Lola (Adkins) Mullins, he was born in Letcher County, Kentucky, on June 12, 1933.

After attending Jenkins High School, Robbie went on to bravely serve his country and was an honorable veteran of the United States Navy. He married Evelyn Gross on August 5, 1957 and started a family of his own with six children. Robbie was a dependable man and purposed his life around protecting and providing for his loving family. A tool and die maker, he was a machinist at FMC, then Koenig Bauer and later retired at the age of 62. In addition, he was a talented handyman and capable of fixing anything. He enjoyed tinkering with parts, working on various projects and making the time to go boating. Robbie was a railway train enthusiast and fixated by the history and mechanical logistics of steam locomotives. A simple, humble and special man, his loving memory will continue to live on with those now left behind.

Along with his parents and loving wife, Evelyn Mullins, he was preceded in death by three brothers, Rodney, Curtis and Daniel Mullins.

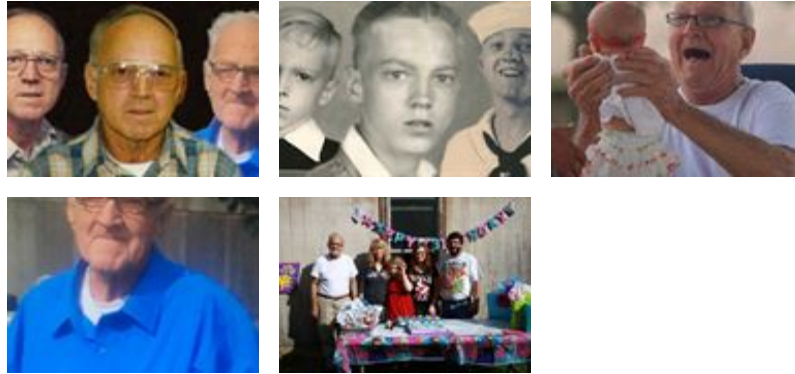
