Ronald E. Brissey, 55, of Mooresville, passed from this life at 3:55am, on Sunday, November 29, 2015, in St. Francis Hospital South, after recently being diagnosed with cancer. He was born on June 24, 1960, in Franklin, to the late Gordon Lee Brissey and Dorothy (Atwood) Brissey Seering.

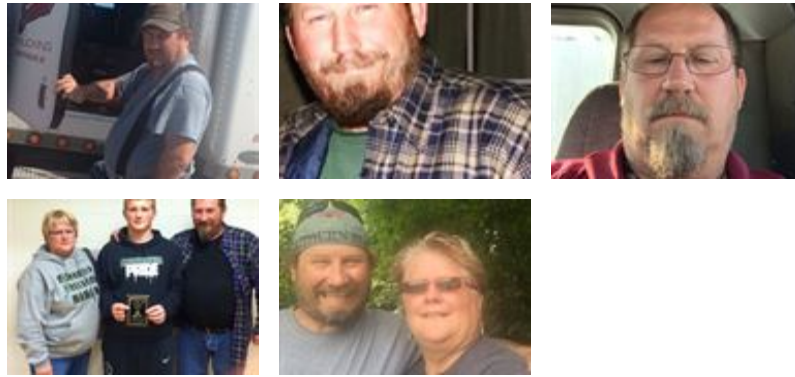

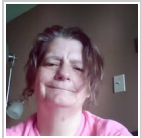
