Ronna Davida Lee, 53, of Monrovia, closed her big beautiful blue eyes for the last time during dialysis and was released to meet her Lord and Savior at 3:24 p.m., on Sunday, June 21, 2020, where she was reunited with her brother Lincoln in Heaven. Ronna was delivered into this world on September 5, 1966, in Martinsville, to her parents David Lee and Holly (Hadley) Satterly.

Living a life of faith in a world full of adversity, the story of Ronna Lee was one of resilience, positivity, compassion, and grace. Despite the challenges and obstacles overcome to live a normal life, she was instilled with Christian morals and traditional family values. She tirelessly baked ample amounts of cookies and white chocolate covered pretzels during the holidays and gave personalized calendars with pictures and important dates to many family members and friends for Christmas.
