



## Stanley Pridemore

March 26, 1949 - June 26, 2020

Stanley Pridemore, 71, of Monrovia, was released of all earthly ailments and joined his son, Stanley, Jr. in Heaven, on Friday, June 26, 2020. He was born in Bedford on March 26, 1949, to the late Kirzie H. and Blanche (Davison) Pridemore.

The youngest of twenty-one children, Stan grew up in Mitchell. At the tender age of 14, he met the love of his life, Marcella. The two dated for four years before marrying after high school and started their cherished family. Drafted into the U.S. Army during Vietnam, Stan bravely served his country for two years. The happy family lived in Milhon Addition, before moving to Echo Lake for eighteen years, then settling comfortably in Wilbur.

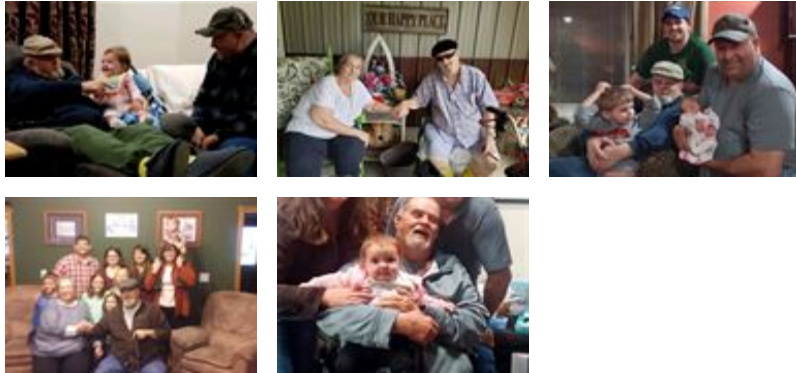

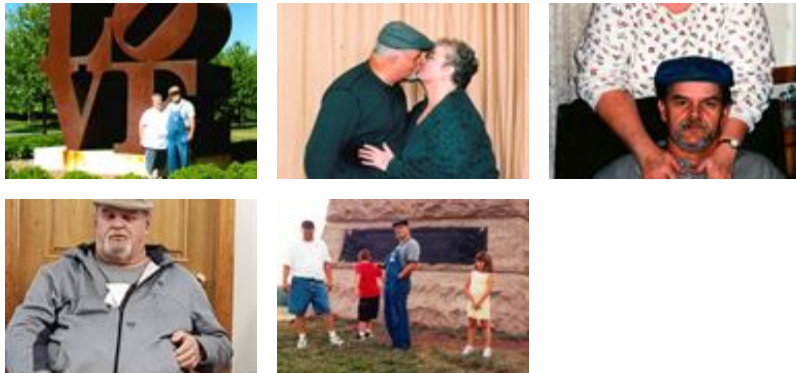
