Tina Michelle Rich, 49, of Monrovia, was called to heaven at 4:10am, on Wednesday, July 25, 2018, while surrounded by her loving family, in the Yellow Rose Hospice Unit of Methodist Hospital. 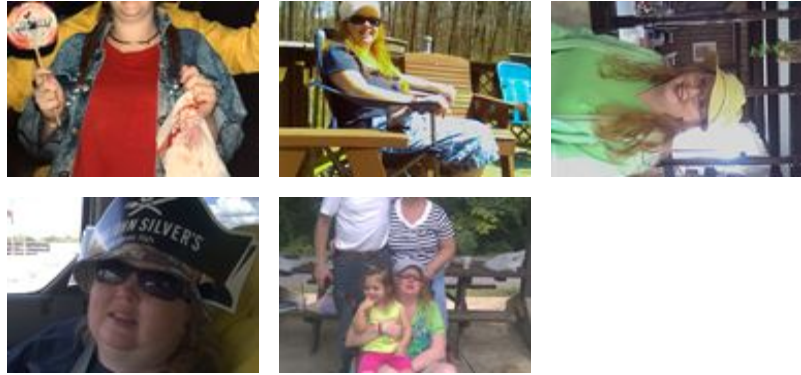
