Adored by anyone that had the privilege of encountering such a warm and caring presence, the premature passing of Tricia (Eubanks) Fisher, who was just 49 years young, has left a void among the entire Monrovia community. Taken to Heaven on Thursday, December 30, 2021, at 12:04pm, after complications of COVID-19 had caused her to be intubated in Hendricks Regional earlier in December. She entered this world on in Martinsville on January 31, 1972, born to David and Sandra (DeFur) Eubanks.

Raised in the Monrovia Christian Church, Tricia also attended the Hazelwood Christian Church with her daughter Gabby, and the Fisher family have been faithful active members at the Mt. Pleasant Christian Church of Hall. A 1990 alumni of Monrovia High School, she continued her education at the International School of Business. Tricia married her best friend and soulmate, Doug Fisher in 1992 and was most proud of being the mother of Gabby and Zach. Previously working in the Plainfield Walmart Jewelry Department, and then as a consultant for Pampered Chef. In 2005, she got her foot in the door with the Monroe-Gregg School district, following family tradition to surround herself with the students she thoroughly enjoyed mentoring. Her warm, caring, and friendly demeanor has undoubtedly left a void within the faculty and students' presence.

Funny, sharp and selfless, she was the rock and solid foundation who thrived to be the base of lifting those around her, because to define her happy was to live a meaningful life.

Knowing that a person will rise only by lifting others up, she strived to do just that, living to value kindness over matter and always keep a smile within arm length. The simplest of life treasures were found in her large loving army of family and friends, especially the two that called her mom. A nurturer by nature and lover by choice, Tricia was a vibrant leader, mentor, and all-around positive person. Her love was limitless, and she was generous to share her time and encouragement with all she knew. For there were no strangers in her world, they were just people she had not yet met. Taking pride in her school, she was a loyal supporter of the Bulldog nation. She was more than a wonderful person, she brought a light into the world, and she lived not in comparison of others, but being the best that she could be.

Blessed are those who have been left to mourn her passing, as she was the type of person that packed the powers of positivity and encouragement as well. She was an all-around loving presence, and a light of love. An all-around generously kind and caring person, the world lost a diamond, and an angel gained its wings.

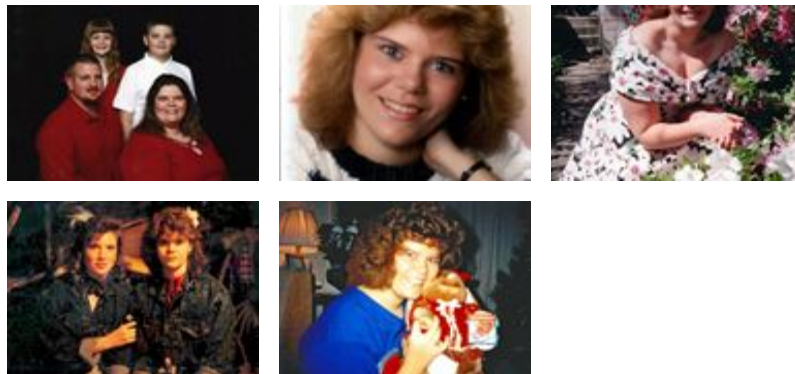
