Virgil Troy Flanagan, 69, of Indianapolis, passed away on Tuesday, February 2, 2016, in IU Methodist Hospital, Indianapolis. Troy was born on March 2, 1946, in Lenoir City, Tennessee.

Troy graduated from Manuel High School in Indianapolis. An entrepreneur and jack of all trades, Troy owned and operated several companies including a gutter business, pool hall, towing company and most recently, TVF, a scrap yard in Indianapolis. 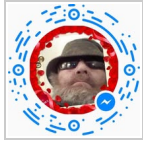
