Warren "Woody" Wood, 71, of Eminence, passed from this life at 4:19 p.m., Tuesday, December 15, 2020, in Franciscan St. Francis Hospital, South Campus. Born to the late, Wilfred Wayne and Helen P. (White) Wood, in Champion, Illinois, he was welcomed into the world on July 18, 1949.

A proud 1967 graduate from Coal Creek Central, Woody attended Purdue University for 3 years, studying animal husbandry. It was there he met his future wife, Colleen.
